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On the day of the appointment, please submit your passport and three photographs to the panel physician. He will require information from the passport to complete the medical examination forms.

Recent changes to United States immigration law now require immigrant visa applicants to obtain certain vaccinations prior to the issuance of an immigrant visa. In order to assist the panel physician, the applicant should have their vaccination records available for the panel physician's review at the time of their scheduled medical examination. See vaccination requirements attached to medical forms.

Your passport will also be required for identification purposes on the day of your appointment at the hospital for x-ray and blood tests.

Please note, the applicant is responsible for all fees pertaining to the medical examination, x-ray and blood tests.
